

The Irish Concrete Society

3rd International Award

The Irish Concrete Society will again make an award to recognise Irish companies who export technical excellence in concrete.

Eligible projects will have commenced after **January 2011** and have been completed by the end of **December 2014**. To be eligible projects must be **located outside the island of Ireland** and have been **designed / delivered by an Irish company** (Architecture or Engineering) or include a **concrete product** manufactured in Ireland.

The Jury shall be appointed by the Council of the Society. The discretion of the Jury is absolute and they will not enter into discussion or correspondence relating to any decisions. The judges may choose not to issue an award should they feel that the standard of entries is below the required standard.

The jury will judge entries on the basis of the following criteria:

- Technical excellence in the use of concrete displayed by the Irish entrant company.
- The entry should represent a significant achievement for the Irish entrant company illustrating ambition in both business and technical aspects.
- Marks will be awarded for the use or development of an innovative solution to overcome a technical challenge.

Unlike other Irish Concrete Society Awards the jury will not visit projects and will only judge on submitted material.

Photographs submitted should be of high quality and may be mounted for public display at the Society Awards Evening or used by the Society for promotional purposes.

Completed forms and submissions must be returned to the Society at the address below before the closing date of **30th of January 2015**.

Entries should include:

- 6 to 12 un-mounted photographs of the structure under construction and when completed. These photographs should be of high or professional quality and illustrate the project's (and Irish entrants) achievements against the competition criteria. Digital versions of the photographs should also be included with the submission. As a guide file sizes should be in excess of 750 kB and be in Jpeg format.
- Key drawings to explain the project, if appropriate.
- A short report (no greater than 4 A4 pages of text) including the following information:
 - A description of the technical excellence in concrete achieved by the project.
 - A clear statement of the contribution of entrant company to achieving the overall project excellence.
 - A detailed description of the Irish Entrants design, construction or production process (as appropriate).
 - A description of how the entry represents a significant achievement for the Irish entrant company in terms of technical excellence.
 - A description of how the entry represents a significant achievement for the Irish entrant company in terms of business development.
 - Outline the innovative solution used or developed to overcome a technical challenge.

Entry closing date **30th of January 2015**. The decision of the Council of the Society shall be final.
