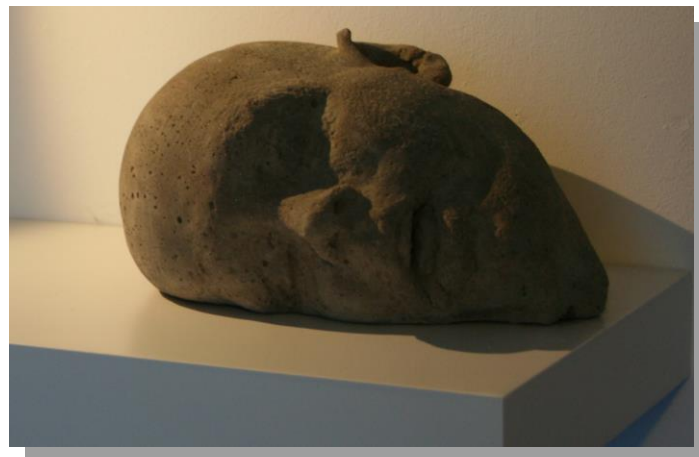
SCULPTURE AWARD

The Irish Concrete Society is pleased to announce the return of a special Award scheme for sculpture. This Award scheme enables the Society to acknowledge the work of sculptors who use concrete as a medium of expression. Entries are eligible which use concrete as the main visual element in the sculpture.

€1,000 is awarded to the winning sculptor

The adjudication will be carried out by an independent jury convened by the Council of the Society.

Nominations for the award may be made by sculptors or others directly involved in the nomination. Nominations must refer to work **completed since August 1st 2015** which is currently in Ireland and which can be made available for inspection by the jury later in the year, if requested.
