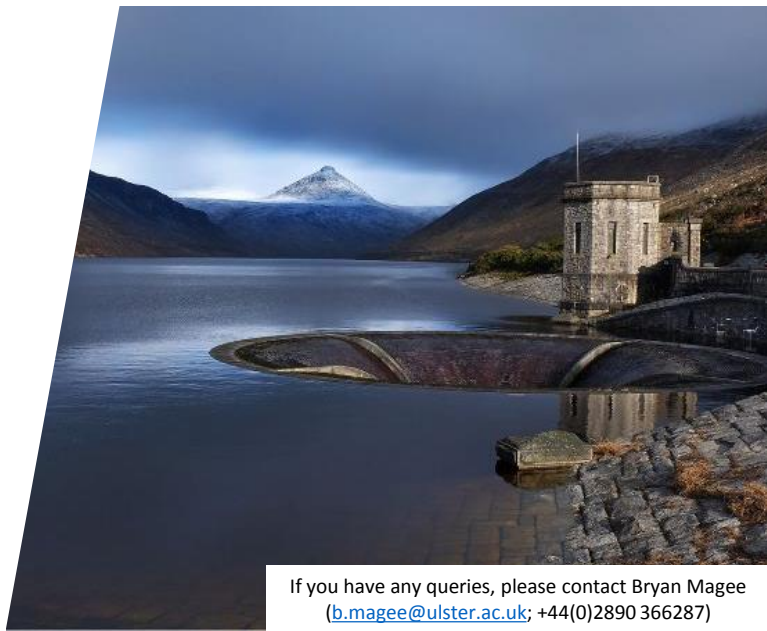
PRESENTATION PREVIEW (20th SEPT, 18:00)

Renowned Chartered Engineer and ex-Concrete Society member, Dr. Philip Donald, will deliver an engaging and unique historic insight into the engineering triumph of the Silent Valley Dams.

From 1800 to 1900, Belfast's population increased from 20,000 to 350,000, leading to demand for increasing quantities of clean water. Philip's talk will explore the problems the engineers of the day, led by L Livingston Macassey, had to overcome to secure the water supply we still rely on today.
