# Irish Concrete Society 12<sup>th</sup> International Award

## Rules of Entry

The Irish Concrete Society will again make an award to recognise Irish companies who export technical excellence in concrete.

To be eligible for entry, projects must:

1. Have commenced no earlier than **January 2020** and be completed by the end of **2024**.
2. Be located outside Ireland.
3. Be designed or delivered by an Irish company (Architecture or Engineering) **and/or** a concrete product manufactured in Ireland.

The jury shall be appointed by the Council of the Society. The discretion of the jury is absolute, they will not enter into discussion or correspondence relating to any decisions. The jury may choose not to issue an award if the entries fall below the standard required.

Entries will be judged on the following criteria:

- Technical excellence in the use of concrete displayed by the Irish entrant company.
- Demonstration of a commitment to sustainability.
- Use or development of an innovative solution to overcome a technical challenge.
- Representing a significant achievement for the Irish entrant company, illustrating both ambition and innovation in the company's overseas target markets.

At least **six (6) high quality images are required** (JPEG format preferred) of the project, under construction and when completed, are required with each entry. Images should be a minimum 150dpi with a 1.5MB file size or greater. These images, which will be retained by the Society, will be used to help the jury form impressions on the merits of the entry and for public display on the Awards Evening. The Society also retains use of these photographs for later promotional purposes. See entry form below for additional entry requirements.

The jury will not visit projects; assessments will be made on the basis of submitted material only.

**Note: Any entry submitted without the required description and images may not be accepted by the jury. All jury decisions are final.**

## Entry requirements:

- Min. 6 high quality digital photographs of the project under construction and when completed. These photographs should illustrate both the project's and Irish entrants' achievements against the competition criteria.
- Key drawings to explain the project, if appropriate.
- A short report (approx. 1,500 words) to include the following information:
  - A description of the technical excellence in concrete achieved by the project.
  - A clear statement of the contribution of entrant company to achieving the overall project excellence.
  - Clearly identify all intellectual and physical components which have been exported from the island of Ireland.
  - A detailed description of the Irish entrant's design, construction or production process (as appropriate).
  - A description of how the entrant company demonstrates its commitment to sustainability.
  - A description of how the entry represents a significant achievement for the Irish entrant company in terms of business development.
  - Outline innovative solution(s) used or developed to overcome a technical challenge.
